GARDENING TIPS

DEVELOPER UPDATE

NEW DEVELOPMENT

The East Village area is expanding with two new phases of development! Twenty-four townhomes will be added to the half-moon parcel (Block 10), and will be fronting the outer loop of Rowcross and along the north side of Golf Drive. Their garages will be accessed via an internal alley of this block. There will be 12 townhomes facing Golf Drive and offered for sale Southern Development. The other 12 townhomes facing the outer loop of Rowcross will be offered for sale by Craig Builders. The developer will start construction in the next 30 to 60 days; the grading and lot improvements will take around three months. Home construction is anticipated to start shortly after that and will continue into the early part of 2024.

The second development (block 31C) will be at the end of Golf Drive and consists of 4 single-family detached homes on the East side of Rowcross adjacent the trail access to Lickinghole Creek. These homes will be offered for sale by Craig Builders. Construction of this site will commence at the same time as the townhome development in Block 10 and homes should begin construction shortly after this.



NEW BUSINESS

The new addition to the Old Trail Village Center is nearing its final stages. This Mixed-Use building includes 31 residential units (1 and 2 bedrooms), constructed with high-quality Condominium style living. Each unit is carefully built with upscale finishes and soundproofing in the walls and floors. Denise Ramey of Long and Foster is leading the leasing, and we've had very strong interest from several new tenants.

The building is designed by Mitchell Matthews Architects in Charlottesville, who did a wonderful job of blending the architecture of this new building to match nicely with the other buildings of the Village Center. There will be a refurbished plaza at the south end of the new building (across from Grit and Coconut Thai) to host future Village Events. We anticipate another dining and entertainment tenant in the new building to also be facing towards this new plaza. We will be targeting another dining/entertainment establishment with outdoor seating at the other North end of the building. Our leasing agent Thalhimer is in talks with several businesses, and we hope to announce tenants very soon.
